

Christmas Bird Count By Bernard Forsythe

December 15th, was mild compared to the early cold we had in November, making it a pleasure for Pauline and I to join in this year's Wolfville Christmas Bird Count. Once again we covered the large area from the White Rock Bridge through to Sunken Lake and then Black River.

Very few birds were present on our walks through the woodlots, except we were pleased to find Ruffed Grouse. Most of the birds counted where at feeders next to the houses. Sunken Lake was frozen so we missed the usual Hooded Mergancers, however we did see Common Mergancers on White Rock pond. Several members of the Finch family have been scarce in recent winters although we have heard reports of some being seen in Kings County.

We found a few Evening Grosbeaks in Black River, while others have reported Pine Grosbeaks, Pine Siskins and Redpolls. A large flock of Redpolls were spotted near Greenfield on camp day. We should be watching for these winter finches in Black River.

By the end of count day we had recorded 19 bird species with a total of 328 individual birds.



Fresh Homemade Salsa

Ingredients

- 8 medium tomatoes
- ¹/₂ cup diced red onion
- 1 jalapeño pepper (serrano pepper also works)
- ¹/₂ cup fresh cilantro
- 1-2 garlic cloves
- 1 tbsp lemon juice
- 1 tbsp lime juice
- 1 tsp salt
- ¹/₂ tsp pepper
- ¹/₂ tsp cumin

Instructions

- 1. Finely dice tomatoes, red onion, jalapeño pepper, garlic and cilantro. Combine in a large bowl and add lemon juice, lime juice and seasoning.
- 2. Alternatively, process all ingredients in a food processor for 30 seconds.

Notes

Storage: Store in the refrigerator in an airtight container for up to 1 week. Jalapeño Peppers: Remove the seeds for a more mild flavour. I personally leave the seeds.
